Pursuant to Rule 41 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, a plaintiff has an absolute right to voluntarily dismiss an action prior to service by the defendants of an answer or a motion for summary judgment. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(i); see also Marex Titanic, Inc. v. Wrecked & Abandoned Vessel, 2 F.3d 544, 546 (4th Cir. 1993). Because no answer or motion for summary judgment has been filed in the instant case, the plaintiff is entitled to voluntary dismissal as a matter of right. Accordingly, it is hereby

## **ORDERED**

that this action is **DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE** and shall be **STRICKEN** from the active docket of the court. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(B) ("Unless the notice [of voluntary dismissal] states otherwise, the dismissal is without prejudice.").
